BEHIND THE NAME:

A number of iconic lighthouses mark our region, but one in particular shines a little brighter. Built in 1821 on Lake Erie's rocky shore, Marblehead Lighthouse is the oldest continuously operating lighthouse on the Great Lakes, and once employed the Great Lakes' first female keeper. Keep watch over our label to find the lighthouse's historic fresnel lens and glacial grooves marking the surrounding terrain.

ABOUT THE STYLE:

Easy-drinking with an appetizing light golden color, the Blonde Ale is an approachable style known for its simplicity and balance. Blonde Ales tend to be lower in alcohol with light, sweet malt flavors and occasionally fruity hop characteristics. They offer the same lightness and effervescence lager drinkers seek, but tend to be more flavorful.
