American Red/Amber Ales developed when California and Pacific Northwest brewers began experimenting with deeper colored malts in their Pale Ale recipes and the trend caught on. A balance of bitterness and sweetness, a medium body and alcohol content make the Red Ale a crowd-pleasing style that blends the best of hops and malt.
